#### **X Important Notes**

- O The reference date for nationality is the application submission date.
- O Applicants for the foreign student admission track whose both parents are foreign nationals are not eligible if either the applicant or one of the parents holds Korean nationality. This restriction also applies to Taiwanese applicants if the applicant or either parent holds Korean nationality.
- O Individuals adopted by foreign nationals and who acquired foreign nationality are only eligible if the foreign nationality was obtained before entering elementary school (G1).
- O Applicants are eligible for the foreign student admission track only if both the applicant and parents acquired foreign nationality before the applicant began education equivalent to Korea's high school curriculum.
- O Recognition of graduation from overseas high schools will be evaluated comprehensively, taking into account the country's education system and academic calendar.
- O Academic backgrounds such as the GED (domestic or international), homeschooling, and online learning (cyber education) are not recognized as valid academic qualifications.
