3. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Document Review	100%	- Comprehensive evaluation based on the submitted documents, considering academic ability, aptitude for the major, personal attributes, potential, etc.

※ An additional oral test or interview may be required if deemed necessary.

4. ELIGIBILITY

A. Nationality: Applicants must meet one of the following conditions.

- 1) Non-Korean with non-Korean parents
- 2) Non-Korean who has completed an education course equivalent to the Korean 12-year formal education course abroad

B. Language proficiency

1) For Applicants in Korean Track: Applicants must meet one of the following conditions.

- i. TOPIK level 2 or higher
- ii. Completion of a Korean Language course of level 3(or higher) at any universities in Korea
- iii. Graduation of an high school or university course taught in Korean
- iv. Demonstrated capacity to study at Ulsan college

※ Foreign students are required to get TOPIK level 3 or higher, or pass a college own test to graduate.

2) For Applicants in English Track: Applicant must meet one of the following conditions.

- i. Citizens of countries where English is the first language or a common language.
- ii. Possession of an official English proficiency test score, such as:
 - a) IELTS 5.5 or higher
 - b) TOFEL 530(CBT 197, iBT 71) or higher
 - c) CEFR B2 or higher
 - d) TEPS 600(New TEPS 326) or higher
 - e) Scores from other English language tests that are deemed equivalent to the above scores.
- iii. Demonstrated capacity to study at Ulsan college

※ Important Notes

- Citizenship status is determined at the time of application submission.
- If the applicant or any one of the applicant's parents has dual citizenship, one being Korean, the student is not eligible for this track. A Taiwanese applicant with one parent of Taiwanese citizenship is also not eligible for this track.
- Korea-born adoptees of foreign nationality are considered as foreign nationals only if they acquired the foreign nationality before entering elementary school (Grade 1).
- Only applicants and both parents, who have acquired foreign citizenship before the applicant started high school education (Grade 10) or the equivalent, are eligible for this track.
- Office of Admissions comprehensively reviews the academic system and semester of individual countries to determine the graduation status of students from overseas high schools.
- GED, home schooling, cyber schooling, or other equivalent certificates are not considered as a high school diploma, thus does not satisfy the minimum criteria for eligibility.
